

RS-CIT Examination Policy

- Section 1 (Internal Exam) – Maximum marks 30 against solving RKCL’s internal assessment. This internal assessment will have combination of objective based and / or interactive assessments. The details of these will be communicated to the Network from time to time. To qualify for main RS-CIT exam as conducted by VMOU, a Learner has to score minimum 40% marks. Marks will be rounded up to calculate final internal assessment marks.
- Section 2 (External Exam) – Maximum Marks 70 against an online / offline exam conducted by VMOU, Kota with minimum 40% as passing marks.
- Separate Passing for Section 1 & 2 is required with Minimum aggregate passing marks 40 out of 100.
- RKCL will declare an exam event. The exam event will always be associated with one or multiple RS-CIT Batches. A learner belongs a batch and any RS-CIT batch will thus be provided maximum 4 exam events.
- RKCL will generate permission letter for learner who gets qualifying marks in Section 1 (Internal Exam), provided learner’s batch is covered in the proposed exam event. In case permission letter is not generated due to insufficient qualifying score in internal assessment marks then the learner will be given an opportunity to complete and qualify internal assessment to attempt next immediate exam event without paying exam fee provided learner’s batch is covered in the proposed exam event, however the learner needs to ensure that he is able to qualify in internal assessment in maximum 4 exam events that has been planned for learner’s RS-CIT Batch.
- In cases where a learner is absent / has failed the main RS-CIT exam conducted by VMOU then the learner can apply in the next immediate exam event by paying prescribed examination fee provided learner’s batch is included as part of the exam event.
- After exhausting all exam attempts, if learner stills fails, then learner has to enroll again as a fresh learner by paying full RS-CIT course fee.
- The learner will need to ensure that all his / her details, photo and sign are captured correctly while taking admission to RS-CIT. In case the learner is not allowed to sit in the exam event due to incorrect details / incorrect photo / incorrect sign that this will not be RKCL’s / VMOU’s responsibility.
- Any additional attempts, if any, may be given only in exceptional cases. This will be on the discretion of RKCL and VMOU and be decided on case to case basis.
